What would you say? You have 30 seconds to make a good impression. Type your script on the slide with the picture</p> <p>Closure:Summarize with students what was learned in class today by having students answer the following statement: What are 4 Soft employment skills you will work to improve?</p>	<p>Class Discussion: Students share what jobs they found on Expresspros.com that might interest them. Now think about the job you really want. What can you do now to prepare yourself to get the job?          Examples: Practice what you would say, keep a good driving record, good grades in school, take courses to learn more.</p> <p>Assessment: Students complete the Elevator Pitch on Google Slides and submit their speech remembering to show good communications skills, ability to work under pressure, be self motivated and flexible. It will be graded on content, correct grammar and spelling.</p>

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
